



# The Colleen Marriott Memorial High School Art Show

## RULES & REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS & TEACHERS

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### General Information

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This competition is open to high school-aged students (9th - 12th grades) living in Bingham County. Public, Charter, Private, and Home school students are welcome to participate. Students should verify their eligibility with their participating High School. Teachers may use their discretion in acceptance of artworks to be entered into the show.

- **ALL WORK MUST BE READY FOR DISPLAY.** Artwork should have a mat or be framed for display. Lightweight pieces with a mat will be attached to the wall using sticky putty. Framed and heavier pieces **MUST** have a wire hanger *securely* attached to the back. (If we can't hang it or put it on a pedestal it will **NOT** be in the show.)
- **The Candy Jar Art Gallery is child friendly.** Please self-screen your art-avoiding political statements, nudity, violence, etc. The Show Chair may restrict art for display.
- **Artwork must be the creation of a single student.** Students may not collaborate on an entry.

Each student may enter up to two entries, however if one piece is particularly large there is a possibility only one will be accepted into the gallery showing. We encourage up to two entries, with the knowledge that we will do our best to accommodate as many art pieces in this show as possible. Because of limited gallery space, some pieces may be subject to being pulled from the show due to lack of space.

**Acceptable art mediums** are (but are not limited to – please verify with your Participating High School Art Teacher):

- Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc
- Drawings: colored pencil, graphite, charcoal, pastel, ink, marker, etc. (we recommended spray fixed.)
- Collages & Mixed Media: must be ready for display
- Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
- Sculpture: clay, fiberglass, etc.
- **NO PHOTOGRAPHY**

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### Student Entry Form and Disclaimer

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Each entry must include a Student Entry Form and Disclaimer attached securely to the back of their artwork. The Student Entry Form and Disclaimer is available on the Bingham Arts Council website at [www.binghamarts.org](http://www.binghamarts.org) or copies will be available for pick up at the Candy Jar Art Gallery (105 NW Main St., Blackfoot, ID 83221). Copies will also be distributed to Participating High School Art Teachers. Forms should be completely filled out with updated contact information for the purpose to create certificates, contact for awards, and returning unclaimed artwork.

The form requires a description of the artwork, which should be detailed, clearly identifying the major elements of the work. Should the form be detached from the artwork it should be easily identified due to the description on the form.

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
